An non-confidential overview of the project is presented, contact information about the involved members and their institutions is given and current events that might be of interest are shown. Furthermore, the website lists deliverables and publications originated from the project, shows current job offers, displays NEUNEU related links and offers an entry point to the internal project wiki system.

The website is hosted at the university computing center of the Friedrich Schiller University, Jena, using the content management system (CMS) EGOTEC 4.2.32 (<http://www.egotec.com/>). The use of a CMS enables all project partners to easily modify the existing project websites and to generate new content in a web interface. In case of accidental deletion or modification, it is possible to return the website to earlier states which are automatically recorded.

Two more services, which are also hosted by the Friedrich Schiller University Jena computing center, are available exclusively for the project partners. A wiki - website is meant as a communication channel, facilitating cooperation by sharing non-public data. A version control system called "Apache Subversion" (SVN) will allow the joint generation of software and manuscripts by many people from different groups at different physical locations.
